The digital health solution targets 2 main groups:

- 1) Older people who feel well and live at home. In this case, the tool will focus on prevention. eCare will help with healthy habits such as quitting smoking, getting more physical activity, among others.

2) Seniors who are fragile and at-risk; i.e. people who are in the hospital or have a health care unit. Our goal is to enable them to gain independence. eCare will help detection by applying innovative indicators.

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What is Pre-Commercial Procurement?

Pre-Commercial Procurement (PCP) is the procurement of research and development of new innovative solutions before they are commercially available. PCP involves different suppliers competing through different phases of development. The risks and benefits are shared between the procurers and the suppliers under market conditions.
